

## THIS FITTING MUST BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR in accordance with the latest AS/NZS 3000 and relevant amendments

#### FOR YOUR SAFETY

- To prevent electrical shock, please ensure that POWER is DISCONNECTED before installation.
- During use the light head and/or light assembly may become hot.
- Do not install in a position where the fitting can be easily accessed by children or the infirm.
- Do not touch any parts of the assembly with bare hands while it is 'ON'.
- · Be aware of the height of your installation. Refer to 'Working at Heights' guide from your local or State Authorities.
- Any alterations or additions to building wiring must be completed by a licensed electrician or person authorised by legislation to work on the fixed wiring of any electrical installation.


# CATANIA TERRAZZO UP/DOWN WALL LIGHT GR

Before first using your new fitting, it is most important that you read and follow these instructions, even if you feel you are quite familiar with this type of product. Retain this document for future reference.

### THIS FITTING MUST BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR in accordance with the latest AS/NZS 3000 and relevant amendments

#### **INSTALLATION**


- 1) Ensure the Mains Supply is switched 'OFF'. (Fig. A)
- 2) Unpack the fixture carefully and place it on a flat surface. Dispose of the packaging material thoughtfully.
- 3) Remove the wall mounting plate from the light housing by unscrewing the 2 x screws. (Fig. B)
- 4) Drill two holes in the wall using the holes in the wall mounting plate as a template. (Fig. C). Note: exercise caution to avoid drilling into existing electrical wiring!
- 5) Feed mains supply cable through the wall and weatherproof holes in wall as appropriate.
- 6) Use screws and suitable fixture system to attach the wall mounting plate to the wall securely. (Fig. C)
- 7) Use the supplied Hex key and remove the screws from the stainless steel cover. Repeat for the other end. (Fig. D)
- Insert the GU10 globe (NOT INCLUDED) into the lampholder and ensure not exceed the maximum wattage 35W. Push the Globe into the housing and place the globe lock ring to secure the globe. Then replace the stainless steel cover and screws removes previously. Repeat for the other end. (Fig. E)
- 9) Unscrew the junction box. Pierce the rubber grommet with a screwdriver and pass the mains supply cable through it. (Fig. F)
- 10) Connect the Live (L), Neutral (N) and Earth according to the markings on the terminal block. Ensure all connections are firm and secure. Replace the screws previously remove from the junction box. Tighten firmly. (Fig. F)
- 11) Refit the light housing to the wall mounting plate, securing it in place using screws removed earlier. Tighten firmly. (Fig. G) NOTE: Apply clear silicone on the housing base which attached onto the wall to maintain IP rating.
- 12) Installation completed. (Fig H)
- 13) Reconnect the mains supply. (Fig. I)
- 14) Turn ON the light.
