

INSTALLATION



- Find a suitable location for your floodlight. Ensure minimum 1m distance from objects and flammable materials.
- Drill two holes in the wall using the holes in the bracket 'B' as a template. Use screws and suitable fixture system 'G' to install the fitting 'A' onto the wall securely.
- **WARNING:** Ensure that the fitting is installed in correct orientation, with CCT switch 'C' facing downwards.
- Plug the cable 'D' into the power point 'W' and turn the power ON.
- Select desired LED colour temperature with switch 'C' located on the bottom of the fitting

I - Warm White (WW) 0- Cool White (CW) II- Daylight (DL)

WARNINGS



- Do not stare directly into operating LED light !
- Check before installation that the mounting surface is suitable for the fixture.
- Do not immerse any part of the fitting into water or any liquid.
- Ensure the mounting bracket is installed firmly.
- During use the light head and/or light assembly may become hot. Do not touch any parts of the assembly with bare hands while it is 'ON'.
- Do not install in a position where the fitting can be easily accessed by children or the infirm.
- Do not install it on surfaced which can move or vibrate.
- Do not cover the fitting with cloth, paper, towel or similar material.
- Do not attempt to perform modification or change parts within the light fixture.
- Switch the power off before cleaning.
- Clean with soft cloth and normal household cleaning aids. Do not use chemicals.
- Operate it at minimum 1m distance away from flammable materials, such as paint, paper, wood etc.
- Ambient temperature over 45C may reduce the life of the product.
- Ensure all screws are tightened.
- Dispose of packaging thoughtfully.
- When the fitting reaches it's end life, recycle in accordance with your local regulations
- Be aware of the height of your installation. Refer to '**Working at Heights**' guide from your local or State Authorities.
